92 Signorello 2002 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon (Napa Valley); \$48. As fine as this Cab is, it's best to leave it alone for some years to develop bottle complexity. It's a big, rich, dry wine, with a huge core of black currant and cassis fruit, but the sticky tannins kick in right away and don't quit. Should be very good after 2008. *Cellar Selection.* —S.H.
